"Mesures" money - Grants that the government is giving. For student activities and to enhance learning in school. Government wants to make these documents public so people can see how much money they are investing in education. Sports Teams should not cost more than \$50. Parascolaire should

cover some of that.

Money was spent for student supervisor and integration aid. Will save some money to hire teachers to help with ministry exams.

Some money waiting for approval. Application process has been completed. grant of \$10,000 for sex ed.

Capital allocation: \$15/kid for furniture

Last year more money was given - money doesn't go very far.

Technology money - 15 smart TVs were purchased Chromebooks were purchased as well. Teacher laptops were purchased - school is responsible.

No overages from last year
IN trust \$3000
\$8000 surplus from last year.
Will be using some of that money to purchase fans.
All items must be purchased by June.
